Gale presented the information she found on other schools booster club membership and how they have them set up.

Sue Sotiros talked about doing a tiered membership approach: Example

\$20.00 Student only

\$30.00 Individual Pass

\$50.00 Family Pass for family of four and under

\$75.00 Family Pass for five or more

\$5.00 for each grandparent under a family pass

Treasurer's Report: Reported by Robyn Williamson

Booster Club funds are extremely low compared to last year.

Report was motioned to be accepted by Michelle Ganzke and seconded by Sue Sader.

Concessions: Reported by Holly Kreckler and Michelle Ganzke

They talked about the spring schedule. They also brought up that they will be talking to the softball coaches to see if they want to run/handle concessions for their games.

Baseball will be taking care of the baseball game concessions.

There are some electrical problems in the outside concessions. Steve Seston had told them he will look into it when it gets warmer.

Need Mascot at more events in order to develop more Team Spirit

Next year they would like to have 2 additional people on the concessions committee.

Talked about some issues they had in the indoor concession stand after it was used by West Allis Lightning. Several items were lost due to the cooler not being on. Also beverages were missing.

Wearable's:

Sold approximately \$1063.00 at conference. Had \$2300.00 in sales that 8th Grade events.

Need to take another inventory of wearable stock.

40 sweatshirts have been stolen from one of the cabinets.

OLD BUSINESS:

Steve Seston will talk to Corey Morgan about the softball loan

Steve Seston talked about uniforms. He would like us to put money aside on an annual basis for the uniform rotation for all sports. We are unable to make any type of commitment at this time due to the financial situation of booster club.

It was brought up that we should consider a \$10.00 uniform fee for each player per sport to be added to the player fee to assist in this area: ex. "uniform rental fee".

Steve Seston will check if we are able to put this add-on fee to the current player fee costs.

Ron Kurtz did not agree with the additional costs. Sue Sotiros thought it was a good idea. This will need to be discussed more at the next meeting.

New Business:

Impact Testing- Steve will have Lisa present the additional information regarding this.

Need to discuss Lisa's contract for the next 3 years. She does not have a signed contract yet. This will also be discussed at next month's meeting.

Elections are to be held at the April meeting, however we will have them in May in order for us to get some interested people that would like to run for an office. Gale Jender will send an email to all members asking if they are interested or if they would like to nominate someone else to a position.

We need to find some other ways to fundraise and to get more people/parents involved.
